

# BUILDING BASICS

**Facade** - front of building

**Horseshoe arch (A)** - curves inward at the bottom, typical of Moorish style

**Stained glass** - decorative colored glass often seen in churches

**Keyhole window** - typical of Romanesque style

**Rose window** - a large round window commonly found in Gothic architecture

**Religious symbol (B)** - on this building, it's a Jewish star, which signals the original use of the building as an Orthodox synagogue

**Transom (C)** - window above a door, could be circular or rectangular

**Parapet (D)** - low wall at the edge of a roof

**Symmetry** - one half mirrors the other

**Pitched roof** - roof that slopes down from a central ridge

**Decorative fence**

**Rectangle-shaped window**

**Repeating windows**

**Brick exterior**

**Multiple stories**

**Multiple entrances**

**Carved wooden doors**

**Stoop** - steps leading to front door

**Below-sidewalk entrance**

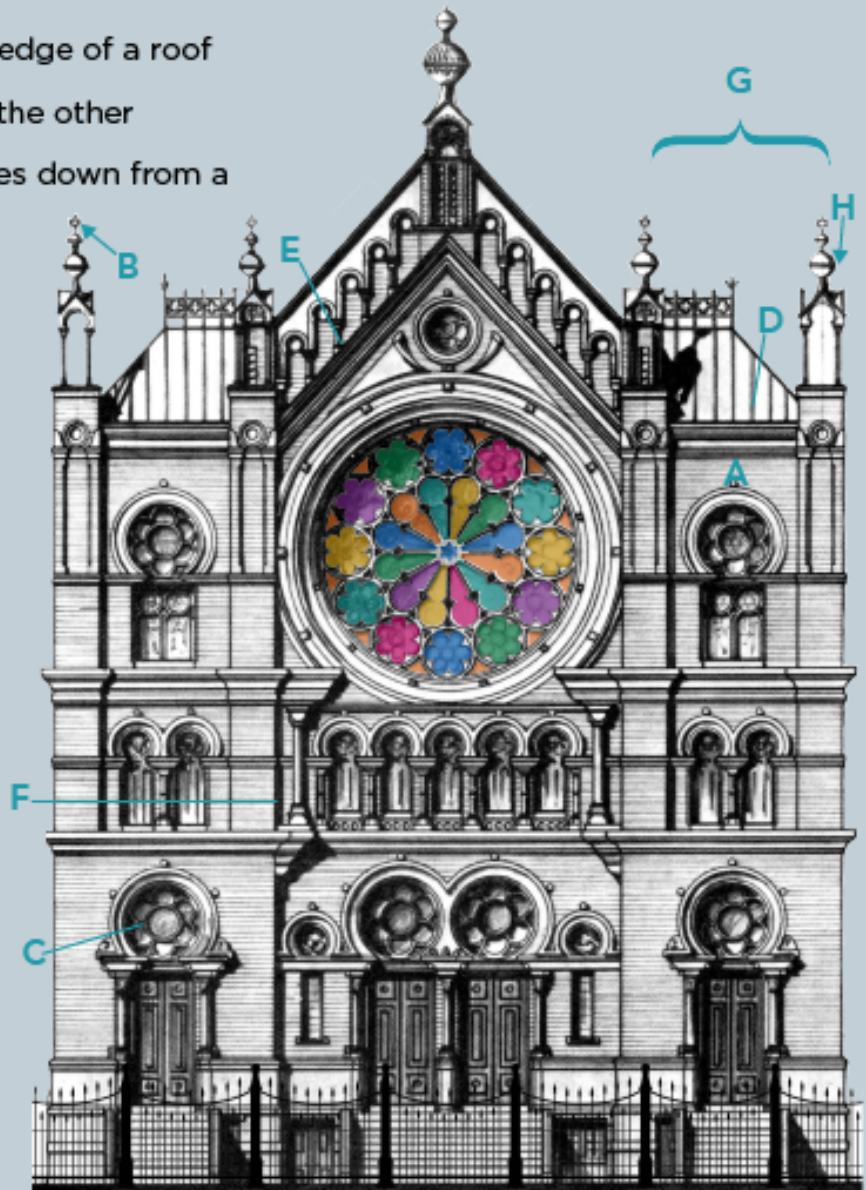
**Cornice (E)** - decoration under roof line - often horizontal, but here it is diagonal
